
Appellant Laurie Knight ("Appellant") filed a Petition for Review ("appeal") with the Idaho Personnel Commission ("IPC") on October 13, 2009 and the IPC issued a Request for Hearing Transcript on October 16, 2009. After inquiry by the Karena Whitmore, IPC Secretary, as to status of transcript preparation on December 17, 2009, Appellant stated her desire to withdraw her appeal to the IPC. Attached as Exhibit A is an email from Appellant evidencing her desire to withdraw her appeal.


