*If you have a work related accident, injury, or occupational disease please follow the steps below.*

**Please Note:** if an injury is life threatening or emergent, please call 9-1-1 or go to the nearest emergency room.

- 1) Notify your supervisor and/or human resources department immediately after an incident even if medical treatment is not required at the time of the incident.
- 2) If you need to seek medical treatment for your incident, the State of Idaho has designated St. Luke's Occupational Health as their preferred medical provider for their work-related accidents, injuries, and occupational diseases. Please visit one of the clinics listed below. If you need to seek treatment outside of clinic hours, please visit one of the after-hours locations.
- 3) After you seek treatment, please contact your supervisor and/or human resources department to discuss your return to work.
